Recently Completed:

- Cesar Millan's new audio book: *Be The Pack Leader* on Random House. The CD was produced by Bob Walter and is the follow up to the highly successful *Cesar's Way* which we recorded at Sunburst and released in 2006. Cesar (The National Geographic Channel's Dog Whisperer) is the author and narrator on both projects.
- The Richard J. Neutra archives for UCLA Powell Library/Special Collections. A Getty Foundation Grant project, the over one hundred hours of taped lectures and interviews allow access to this valuable audio asset (transferred from analog tapes to Mitsui Archive CD-R's) for research in the field of Architecture. Neutra was not only a world renowned Modernist Architect but also a Humanist and visionary for city planning in the 20th Century.
